

The Need




7500 defects in 1MLOC

1050 defects
in 1MLOC
10500 defects
in 10MLOC

Test-based QA practices

- Testing finds less than 50% defects,
- Advanced software groups use inspections, which are effective but limited:
 - A 1KLOC program listing has 30 pages,
 - 1 defect/KLOC is 1 defect in 30 pages,
 - 100 defects/MLOC is 1 defect in 300 pages,
 - 10 defects/MLOC is 1 defect in 3000 pages,
 - 1 defect/MLOC is 1 defect in 30000 pages.



Team Software Process (TSP)

 Level 5 Process for a team which includes non-developers: hardware, test, SQA, systems, users...

 The quality of every member's work is a team concern.

 The focus is on "building in" quality rather than "testing it in!"


Team Software Process (TSP)

- TSP team gathers and uses data to:
 - Produce their own plans,
 - Negotiate their own commitments,
 - Track and report their own work,
 - Manage quality of their own products,
 - Consistently meet their own commitments.




Personal Software Process (PSP)

- Level 5 Process for developers and non-developers,
- Goal is to find and fix every defect before test entry,
- Achieved through PSP training and management support.



Benefits



7500 defects in 1MLOC

60 defects in 1MLOC

(Improvement:

17.5X vs. CMM L5

125X vs. CMM L1)

- Get it going on your own.


